1. How does Paul's statement in 1 Corinthians 1:10-13 (“Let there be no divisions among you”) impact modern-day denominationalism?
2. According to Christ's own words in Matthew 16:18-19, exactly how many churches did He say He was going to establish?
3. In 1 Corinthians 3:11, Paul discussed the foundation of the church. Who or what was that foundation?
4. According to Peter's statement in Acts 4:11-12, Jesus Christ plays an important part in the construction of the church. What is that part?
5. Colossians 3:17 teaches us that we are to do what we do in the church according to a certain authority. What is that authority?
6. According to Hebrews 12:23, the names of faithful Christians are registered in a certain place. What is that place?
7. What is the important message found in 1 Corinthians 4:6?
8. What is the important message found in Revelation 22:18-19?
9. At what point in history, according to the prophecy contained in Daniel 2:44, was the Lord's kingdom (or church) to be established?
10. In Acts 28:30-31, Paul preached the church/kingdom as a “present reality.” During the reign of what earthly kingdom was he doing his preaching?
11. What important points is contained in Mark 9:1 that proves that Christ's church/kingdom has already been established?
12. According to the prophecy contained in Micah 4:1-2, where would the Lord's church/kingdom be established?
13. According to Ephesians 3:10-11, what is the purpose of the church?
14. According to Romans 16:16, what is one scriptural name for the church?
15. According to Philippians 1:1, what is the scriptural organization of the church?
16. According to Acts 2:47, how does one get into the church?
17. Ephesians 1:22-23 teaches that the church is the body. According to Ephesians 4:4, how many bodies did Christ establish?
18. What steps must a person take to be saved and thereby enter Christ's church?
